

Dear UB Guest:

Welcome to the University at Buffalo Campus Living. Check-in hours are 8:30 AM to Midnight, Sunday through Saturday and check-out is by noon on your departure date. Should you need to check-in at a different time, please contact the check-in site on your day of arrival. A map and directions immediately follow this letter to aide you in finding the check-in site.

The following should assist you in planning for your arrival and stay on campus:

- ◆ You will receive your room assignment at check-in (please indicate the name of your group, internship or UB department).
- ◆ Possession of the room key and access card are considered to constitute room occupancy. If you decide not to stay on campus, return your room key immediately. Charges will accrue for the period of time that the key is in your possession.
- ◆ ***Your room will be equipped with: single beds, dressers, desks, and chairs. You will receive a bagged set of linen (bed sheets, blankets, towels, and washcloths).*** You must provide any personal items. Cooking in student rooms is prohibited by New York State law and University regulations. Kitchenettes equipped with stoves, microwaves and sinks are available on each floor.
- ◆ Refrigerators are not provided. We suggest that you bring a small “dorm” size unit for your room.
- ◆ Please note that Greiner Hall is air conditioned.
- ◆ Wi-Fi is available throughout all residence halls. Instructions for accessing the UB network will be provided at check-in.
- ◆ There are no public telephones in Greiner. We suggest that you bring a personal cell phone.
- ◆ Each room is equipped with cable, but you must supply your own television. Public lounges are also equipped with televisions.
- ◆ Each residence hall has laundry facilities, which are free of charge. You must supply your own soap
- ◆ Each housing complex has a fitness center for use by students and other summer guests. Residents of Greiner Hall may use the Richmond Fitness center, which is located in the adjacent Ellicott Complex. Please check with your hall office for hours.



Summer Conference Housing In Greiner Hall

Located adjacent to the Ellicott Complex, Greiner Hall offers suite style housing. Each air conditioned suite includes two double rooms with an adjoining private bathroom and storage area. This newest "Green" facility opened in August 2011 and can house nearly 600 residents. Greiner Hall is "Universally" designed with complete access for people with varying physical and cognitive abilities. **Unless otherwise specified, all check-ins take in the Greiner Hall Office (A102 Greiner Hall). It is located in the "A-Wing" on the northern most end of the facility, near the Au Bon Pain café.**



The North Campus is at Route 263 (Millersport Highway) and Maple Road. From the New York State Thruway (1-90), Proceed **west taking exit 50 to 1-290 (Youngmann Expressway)**, and exit at **Millersport Highway North (exit 5B)**. When you exit onto Millersport Highway, proceed through one traffic light (Flint Road intersection), past the Maple Road exit, and continue the State University exit (**SUNYAB-Flint Entrance**).

Directly to your right is the academic wing of the north campus. You are on John James Audubon Parkway. Continue on the parkway to the third light, Hamilton Road. **Turn left (north) onto Hamilton Road.** Greiner Hall is located at the end of Hamilton Road, near the tunnel entrance to the Ellicott Complex. You may park in the Fargo lot on the right. **Note, when using GPS, the coordinates for the Fargo parking lot are as follows:**

You will be meeting at the **Greiner Hall Office located in the "A wing" (phone 716-645-8900)**. The entrance to the "A wing" is on the left side of Greiner Hall (north end). It is also adjacent to the Au Bon Pain café. When you pass through the double set of glass doors, the front desk of the Hall office is directly on your right.




